#### D. Reports:

#### 1. Chair Report- Sam Cradduck

#### 3. Treasurer's Report- Dharini Dobbins

 a. The treasurer's report was submitted, showing a balance of \$1325. No debits, transactions or credits were recorded.

#### E. Guest Speaker - Dr. G & Dr. Cha (Desert Valley Medical Group)

- **a.** Dr. Cha and Dr. G from Desert Valley Medical Group presented on healthy aging, preventative care (screening), vaccinations, and nutrition.
- b. Drs. Cha and G discussed key screening measures including mammograms, pap smears, cholesterol level checks, blood pressure monitoring, BMI, DEXA scans for osteoporosis, and CT scans for lung cancer.
- **c.** Dr. G emphasized the importance of vaccinations, including COVID-19 boosters, flu shots, pneumococcal, Tdap, and shingles vaccines.
- **d. Record Transfers:** When changing doctors or states, it's important to share your records from your previous state or doctor.
- **e. Hydration:** Drink plenty of water before getting shots or blood tests.
- f. Covid is mutating: And boosters may be necessary.
- g. Amyloid plaques cannot: be reduced with lifestyle modification.
- h. Importance of Protein: What our bodies need the most is protein. Protein can help with vegetable sources. It can come from eggs, it can come from meat, it can come from fish, seafood. Avocados, bananas and apples all have fiber.

- i. Good vs Bad fats: Avoid palm oil, and highly processed or simple carbohydrates. Whole grain is preferrable over bread.
- j. Women can have different signs: that they're having a heart attack than men.
